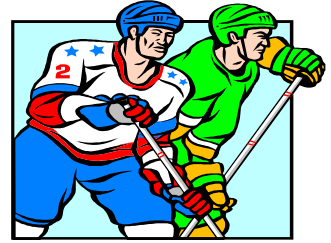


Spring 2009 Adult Roller Hockey League

Additional Information and Rules

- ◆ Rosters can be faxed to 983-0062, emailed to ibchadbehrens@aol.com, or dropped off with your registration. Rosters MUST be completed by May 18. Any additions or changes to your roster after this date must be approved by the commissioner.
- ◆ All players must play a minimum of 4 games to be eligible for playoffs
- ◆ Fighting and intent to injure will result in a 2 game suspension for the 1st offense, 5 games for the 2nd offense, and 3rd offense 1 year probation and suspension length will be determined by the commissioner. Suspensions carry over from season to season.
- ◆ If an team plays with an ineligible or suspended player, it will result in a forfeit for the team and an additional one game suspension for the suspended player.
- ◆ Commissioner has right to review all suspensions
- ◆ Periods are (2) 22 minute running clock
- ◆ If still tied during regular season, there will be a 3 man shoot-out. During playoffs will be a sudden death period
- ◆ All players MUST wear a similar jersey color and have a number present. If not, a minor “delay of game” penalty will be assessed prior to the game.
